

The cost of services provided by C²D³ will vary based on school or district ability to offset costs including space rental, materials reproduction, and catering. The estimates below are provided to aid districts in budgetary planning and as a starting place for negotiating specific services. Graduate credit can be purchased for all training.

Service

Cost Estimate

Multi-district institute participation	\$125 per person, per day (includes lunch)
On-site training or coaching	\$650—\$1,000 per coach per day + travel and materials
Annual participation in the IBEP Learning Community	\$600 per person per year (includes 6 in-person sessions)
On-line courses	\$150 per person for 4-week course
On-line access to IBEP standards, Innovation-Configuration Map, and other needs assessment tools	Free

The Colorado Consortium for Data-Driven Decisions (C²D³) was established in August of 2003 with support from a grant from the Colorado Department of Education (CDE). A consortium of over 50 Colorado school districts, BOCES, and institu-

C²D³ fosters information-based educational practices by:

- Providing **Professional Learning Experiences and Coaching** for educators and educational leaders.

Information-Based Educational Practice

- Clearly define learning.
- Use quality assessment instruments and practices to select, evaluate, and revise instruction.
- Use classroom assessment formatively to support students taking responsibility for their own learning.
- Use collaborative inquiry to analyze and interpret data.

- Establishing and supporting the **IBEP learning community**.

- Providing a human and web-supported **knowledge infrastructure** about IBEP, including tools and examples.

- Supporting **data-driven school improvement planning**.

Professional Development and Coaching available through C²D³ is differentiated based on educator needs. Learning opportunities include in-person, multi-district institutes, individual district workshops, on-

line learning, and on-site coaching.

C²D³ supports the **IBEP Learning Community** to expand the capacity of professionals currently serving in coaching and staff development roles. The learning community provides training and support to implement information-based educational practice. Learning Community members meet bi-monthly and have access to training and coaching resources created by C²D³.
